Weeks 6 – 15, Tuesdays 12:00 – 2:00 pm

Weekly class meetings introduce students to community needs assessment, promote discussion of the role of government and citizens in a social welfare state, and include guest speakers and roundtable discussions.

Students complete 45 hours of community service, keep a service project reflection journal, and complete a final documentary assignment.

Service projects in local schools, hospitals, non-profits, NGOs, and businesses.

Weeks 6 – 15

Complete an additional 112.5 hours of service-learning, two service-learning reflection papers, and a “needs assessment and design paper” to receive 3 more credits for your service-learning project.

You can choose to complete additional hours at the same site or add one additional service site.

You can complete 11 additional hours per week during weeks 6-15 or you can conduct a 10-day intensive service project over spring break to satisfy the service-learning hours requirement for this course.

APPLICATION INFORMATION AND DEADLINES

12 or more three-day weekends (Friday through Sunday)

9-days off for spring break (which could be spent doing an intensive service project)

2 group excursions on environmental and economic sustainability as part of the program (2-3 days each)

1 research trip on sociocultural sustainability funded with program fees (3-5 days)

1 weekend travel excursion through the Centro de Lenguas Modernas funded with program fees (2-3 days)

PROGRAM CALENDAR

B.S. in Applied Languages and Intercultural Studies (ALIS) – 33 total credit hours of 3/4000-level Spanish coursework, with at least one class from each of the following areas: - Societies and Cultures, - Industry and Technology, - Arts and Media. Plus 2 courses in Advanced Language Acquisition, 6 courses (18 credit hours) of elective courses in the language area, and the Intercultural Seminar Capstone course SPAN 4500

B.S. in International Affairs and Modern Languages (IAML) – International Affairs courses + 24 credits of Spanish electives beyond 2002

B.S. in Global Economics and Modern Languages (GEML) – Economics courses + 24 credits of Spanish electives beyond 2002

Spanish Minor - 15 credits of Spanish electives beyond 2002

Spanish Certificate - 12 credits of Spanish electives beyond 2001

Humanities Credit – 6 credits of Humanities for SPAN 3301
