## SPAN 4693 (3 CREDITS) SUSTAINABILITY IN SPAIN




Weekly class meetings introduce students to community needs assessment, promote discussion of the role of government and citizens in a social welfare state, and include guest speakers and roundtable discussions.

Students complete 45 hours of community service, keep a service project reflection journal, and complete a final documentary assignment.

Weeks 6 – 15

Complete an additional 112.5 hours of service-learning, two service-learning reflection papers, and a "needs assessment and design paper" to receive 3 more credits for your service-learning project.

You can choose to complete additional hours at the same site or add one additional service site.

You can complete 11 additional hours per week during weeks 6-15 or you can conduct a 10-day intensive service project over spring break to satisfy the service-learning hours requirement for this course.
