

DECORATION THEME

There are two decoration themes for your office to choose from: (1) The Ramblin' 20s and (2) Beat WAKE FOREST.

DECORATION SCOPE |

We have seen in recent years that some offices are able to devote a whole team's efforts to a large scale decoration, while others are limited by time and personnel to just a single door. With that in mind, departments can choose to decorate either (1) a single door in their office or (2) an entryway or vestibule. Prizes will be awarded to the top scoring submission in each Decoration Scope category.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

Please submit your application using this <u>short survey</u> by Friday, October 13th at 5pm. Application queries should be e-mailed to Kate Curnow at <u>kate.curnow@stucen.gatech.edu</u>. There is no application fee, but departments must cover the costs of their supplies.

DECORATION DEADLINE

Doors should be decorated by Monday, October 16th by 5pm. Judging will take place from Tuesday, October 17th until Thursday, October 19th. Winners will be announced Friday, October 20th. Decorations should be left up through Homecoming Weekend to assist in the promotion of Homecoming events and spirit.

RULES |

- 1. The designs will be judged on the creative interpretation of the chosen decoration theme, their artistic quality, and the overall design of the display.
- 2. Each departments may only have one submission.
- 3. A staff member does not have to be present during judging.
- 4. Any entries containing materials deemed offensive by the judging committee will be immediately disqualified and the department will be asked to remove the decorations. These will not be judged.

CRITERIA |

Decorations will be judged based upon the following criteria:

Creativity 30 points
Adherence to Chosen Theme 20 points
Incorporation of Departmental Work* 10 points
Artistry 10 points
Overall Design 30 points

Total available points: 100

*Examples include Health Services incorporation of flu shots, Parking & Transportation's use of transit elements, etc.

PRIZES |

Prizes will be awarded to the highest scoring team in each Design Scope category.

Entryway/Vestibule: Tech Rec Party

- -Two hour bowling party for your office.
- -Includes unlimited bowling for up to 20 people (maximum of 5 lanes).
- -Available Tuesdays Thursdays. Must be during normal Tech Rec business hours.

Single Door: Paper & Clay Party

- -Ceramic glazing for up to 10 people.
- -Free ceramic piece, including glazing and firing (\$8 maximum piece value).
