

Visit of Ambassador Luis Gallegos, J.D.



You are invited to join us for the visit of Ambassador Luis Gallegos to the Georgia Institute of Technology on February 24, 2017.

Ambassador Gallegos is an Ecuadorian diplomat who served as the Permanent Representative of Ecuador to the United Nations (UN) in Geneva and in New York, as Ambassador to the United States and served as Chair of the UN General Assembly Ad-hoc Preparatory Committee of the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities. He was a member of the UN Committee against Torture and President of the International Rehabilitation Foundation; currently Chairman of the Global

UN Partnership for Inclusive Information and Communication Technologies (G3ict). Also, Ambassador Gallegos is a board member for the Special Olympics.

The Ambassador's lecture will highlight the inspiring launching of the first international treaty recognizing the rights with persons with disabilities. The Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (CRPD) just celebrated the 10th anniversary of its adoption by the United Nations. The Ambassador will be accompanied by Axel Leblois, President and Executive Director of the Global Initiative for Inclusive Information and Communication Technologies (G3ict).
