

Epic Intentions Spring 2017 Projects

1. Project Live Love
 - a. Project Live Love is a network of nonprofits that work on various causes (e.g. homelessness, sex trafficking, drug and alcohol rehabilitation and more) to spread love.
 - b. Project Description: Create a web platform to connect volunteers with a volunteer opportunity.
2. GT-STAR
 - a. Students' Temporary Assistance and Resources (STAR) is an organization that provides stability for students to pursue a fulfilling college experience.
 - b. Project Description: Create a web app that helps find low price housing for GT students in need.
3. LEAADS
 - a. LEAADS is a mentor program for at-risk youths.
 - b. Project Description: Create a website about LEAADS
4. EXCEL
 - a. Excel (Expanding Career, Education and Leadership Opportunities) at Georgia Tech is a four-year program for students with mild intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD), leading to two separate certificates.
 - b. Project Description: Create a platform that matches mentors with mentees based on similar interests.
5. The International Human Trafficking Institute (IHTI)
 - a. IHTI is a program within the National Center for Civil and Human Rights that aims to connect college groups working to combat human trafficking.
 - b. Project Description: Create a mobile app on iOS that will collect data on whether buildings are following laws about posting the Human Trafficking Hotline, based upon already made app mock-ups.
6. H.E.R.O. for Children, Inc.
 - a. H.E.R.O. for Children is a non-profit dedicated to improving the quality of life for children infected with and affected by HIV/AIDS.
 - b. Project Description: Designing and installing a database for storing, accessing, and performing analytics on client data.
7. Georgia Justice Project
 - a. Georgia Justice Project defends people accused of crimes, and win or lose, stand with them while they rebuild their lives.
 - b. Project Description: Developing a relational database to maintain legal and social service client information and monitor progress toward goals.
8. Next Generation Men
 - a. Next Generation Men is an organization built by real teachers dedicated to inspiring young students of color to success through professional exposure, leadership development, community service, and ongoing support.
 - b. Project Description: Improve web application for monitoring student progress.
9. Project Open Hand
 - a. Open Hand helps people prevent or better manage chronic disease through Comprehensive Nutrition Care, which combines home-delivered meals and nutrition

education to reinforce the connection between informed food choices and improved quality of life.
