	Driving South on I-75/85 into Atlanta	Take Exit #249D (North Avenue). At the top of the exit ramp, turn right onto North Avenue. Cross Techwood Drive (the first light) and continue on North Avenue approximately two blocks to Cherry Street. Turn right onto Cherry Street and then left onto Ferst Drive. Park in the visitor's parking lot (Area 2) adjacent to the Student Center. Parking fee on March 28: \$5.00 (flat rate).
	Driving North on I- 75/85 into Atlanta	Take Exit #249D (North Avenue, Spring Street, West Peachtree Street). At the top of the exit ramp, proceed through the first intersection (Spring Street). At the next intersection (West Peachtree), turn left. Continue on West Peachtree for approximately one block and turn left on North Avenue. Cross over the interstate and Techwood Drive. Turn right onto Cherry Street and then left onto Ferst Drive. Park in the visitor's parking lot (Area 2) adjacent to the Student Center. Parking fee on March 28: \$5.00 (flat rate).
	MARTA	Metropolitan Atlanta Rapid Transit Authority: Georgia Tech is served by two rail stations: the North Avenue Station and the Midtown Station. These stations can be accessed by the Red and Gold lines. The Tech Trolley provides a direct connection to campus from the Midtown Station. Leave the Midtown station through the south exit, where the Trolley picks up passengers and takes them to and from several campus locations, including the Student Center. The Trolley runs every 36 minutes on Saturdays and the ride is always free. Alternately, one can access the Student Center by walking five blocks west of the North Avenue Station. Turn right at Cherry Street and then left at Ferst Drive. The Student Center is approximately ¼ of a mile on the right.
	CCT	Cobb Community Transit: Buses on route #10 from Marietta or the Cumberland Boulevard Transfer Center travel to the Arts Center MARTA Station. Express buses on routes #100 (from the Town Center Mall area) and #101 (from the Cobb County Civic Center) also travel to the Arts Center Station. Then take a southbound MARTA train and get off at the next station, Midtown. The Tech Trolley provides a direct connection to campus from the Midtown Station. Leave the Midtown station through the south exit, where the Trolley picks up passengers and takes them to and from several campus locations, including the Student Center. The Trolley runs every 36 minutes on Saturdays and the ride is always free. Alternately, one can access the Student Center by walking five blocks west of the North Avenue MARTA Station. Turn right at

Cherry Street and then left at Ferst Drive. The Student Center is

approximately ¼ of a mile on the right.
