DETAILS

- A 12-month, full-time assignment with three rotations, each lasting approximately four months. The program graduation period is flexible and candidates graduate anywhere from 12–15 months into the program.
- The program is led by the Global Director of Procurement who works with supply chain leaders throughout the company to identify the four-month assignments. We strive to provide diverse experiences across the three assignments.
- Most assignments are located in Kohler, Wisconsin, while other U.S. locations and international assignments are occasionally available.
